

**PAGE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
September 26, 2016**

A Regular Meeting of the Page Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was held at 5:30 p.m. on September 26, 2016 in the Council Chambers at City Hall in Page, Arizona. Chair Brian Carey presided.

**5. UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

A. Discussion-Draft Page City-wide Parks Master Plan

Leslie Dornfeld from Plan\*et attended by phone. Leslie stated that she used Arizona communities as funding examples because other states have different tools. The board wants examples from smaller communities and where they received funding for parks such as Kanab, Utah. The board also requested information on how much the benchmark communities spend to maintain their parks.

B. Discussion and Possible Action-John C. Page Memorial Park Master Plan

Community Development Director Kim Johnson presented the latest rendition of John C. Page Memorial Park Master Plan pointing out items that had been left off of the previous rendition. Kim stated that the pictures still need to be changed. Chair Brian Cary asked if there would be narrative to support the map.

Community Services Director Debbie Winlock stated concerns that the Townhouse might be changed to a Teen Center. Kim Johnson stated the Teen Center could have other possible locations on the map.

**6. NEW BUSINESS**

A. Discussion and Possible Action-Adopt a Spot Program

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City Manager Crystal Dyches asked if the board would get behind a program such as Adopt A Spot.

Susan Pilkington stated that she thought it would be a good idea although it might be met with resistance at first. Angie Crim likes the idea from a business perspective. Steve Mongrain stated it would be good to have volunteer help. Erik Stanfield suggested starting a pilot program with a few priority places.

City Manager Crystal Dyches stated that she hears support from this board and she is also presenting the program to the Community Development Board for their input.

**B. Discussion Park Master Plan Implementation Plan**

Steve Mongrain briefly discussed the implementation plan that he created. He suggested everyone go over it in their spare time. Community Development Director Kim Johnson suggest filling the plan in by priority. Chair Brian Carey would like to have a work-session with the City Council to discuss the implementation.

**C. Discussion and Possible Action-Coconino County Parks & Recreation Commission-Page Representative**

Recreation Division Director Jacquelyn La New was contacted by Coconino County looking for representation from the Page area to be on the County Parks & Recreation Commission. Jacquelyn has the contact information for any interested citizen or board member. Steve Mongrain stated that he would be interested if no one else was.

**D. Discussion-Next Meeting Date/s (October/November)**


The next meeting will be Monday, October 24, 2016 and then November 1, 2016.
