**Deadline:** Registrations and fees will be accepted only at City Hall May 10 - **July 19**. Late registration is not guaranteed. If space remains after **July 19**, late registrations *may* be accepted with an additional \$10.00 late fee.

**Fees:** **\$50/child** Mustang, Bronco, T-Bred (Grades 2-8) leagues; **\$40/child** Pee Wee, Pony (Grades PreK-1) leagues.

**Coaches:** In this community-based league, all coaches are volunteers. We encourage parents, grandparents, and 16+ year old siblings, to coach their players’ teams. If interested, please contact the Recreation Department at 928-645-4380/4381 for volunteer forms. **Volunteer forms must be completed annually before the coaches’ organizational meetings** (New coaches August 10<sup>th</sup>, Returning coaches August 15<sup>th</sup>) at 6:00 PM at the Page Community Center.

## Teams/Equipment:

- **Requests to put players on teams together or with specific coaches will not be accepted.** The Recreation Department sorts players by experience to create teams of similar skill levels and these types of requests contribute to unequally balanced teams. Other than parents coaching their children or placing siblings who are in the same league on the same teams, no other effort will be made to place players on specific teams.
- One team shirt and one pair of soccer socks per player is included with registration.
- For safety, soccer cleats (no toe spikes or metal cleats) and shin guards are required to play.
- **Shoe exchange:** Beginning August 17, soccer shoes may be dropped off at the Sports Complex for donation. Beginning August 24<sup>th</sup>, participants may select shoes for their own use (See website or Facebook for further details).
