**MINUTES**

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

1. Continuation of work toward creation of a vision and mission statement.

Motion made Ron Macdonald to continue to table this agenda item. The motion was duly seconded and passed upon a vote.

2. Being a larger presence in the Page community. This item is a continuing project and will continue to be listed under unfinished business. Larry Clark requesting other city agencies to attend. Member of the SATF Authority will attend the GASO on 11/17/16 presented by the PHS U.N.I.T.Y. club.

3. Scholarship funding. Discussion on when and how advertise this item. Ron Macdonald moved to table this agenda item, second made, motion passed upon vote.

**New Business**

1. Freshman Focus at Page High School. This activity has been postponed until the spring.

2. Discussion about whether SATF members can do presentations for Triple A sessions at Page High School. The Assistant Principle advised that they do not want to attempt it, now, but possibly during the second semester. There were several students attending from PHS and they were quite enthused about this idea, they advised that they also would make a request to PHS administration that they would like to have these presentations made.

3. Member from local police department to update SATF on activities involving drugs and alcohol in the community. No one from police department attended.

4. Status of Page SATF drug drop box at Page Public Safety facility. As no one from that agency attended the question could not be answered. Member Santelli did however let the members know

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that Canyon Lands has a drop box at their new pharmacy.


5. Presentation by Gregg Martinez for possible funding of a program associated with the Page Regional Domestic Violence Services. Gregg gave a review of the scope of services that PRDVS provides and their vision for including training for their personnel on dual diagnosis issues. He advised that there is a large need for training of their program advocates, but would like to see a coalition with our group to help develop or access people in the industry who can help provide this type of training. The PRDVS is not specifically asking for funds from the SATF, now.

6. Do members of the SATF authority want to continue having the notes and agendas of meetings e-mailed to them prior to the meeting date. All members indicated that they would like it to continue.


