City Of Page Voters To Receive Ballots For General Election — *To be mailed Wednesday, April 22* —

Flagstaff, Az. – On Wednesday, April 22, the Coconino County Elections office will mail ballots to **ALL** registered voters within the city limits of Page for the May 19, 2009 City of Page General Election. This election is a **vote-by-mail** election and there will be no polling places on Election Day.

In order to vote in the upcoming City of Page Primary, a citizen must live within the boundaries of the Page city limits and be registered to vote by April 20, 2009.

The ballot contains the top two mayoral candidates from the March 10, 2009 Primary Election. Voters may vote for only **ONE** candidate. In addition, there are four candidates vying for two remaining City Council seats. Voters may vote for no more than **TWO** candidates.

Voters who do not receive their ballot by Wednesday, April 29 should contact the Elections Office at (928) 779-6589 or toll-free (800)-793-6181. The Elections Office can mail a “replacement ballot”, or a voter may request and vote a “replacement ballot” in person at the Page City Clerk’s Office.

Voters have until 7:00 p.m. on Election Day to return their ballot. A voter has the option of mailing their ballot, but it must be received in the Elections office, or dropped off at the Page City Clerk’s Office, 697 Vista Ave, by **7:00 p.m. on Election Day**.
