**PROCLAMATION RESCINDING THE NOVEMBER 18, 2020,  
PROCLAMATION RELATING TO COVID-19**

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, declared that a State of Emergency exists in Arizona due to the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, former Mayor of the City of Page, Levi Tappan, declared that a State of Emergency exists in the City due to the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2020, Governor Ducey issued certain requirements for restaurants and bars as well as requirements for all businesses in Arizona to slow the spread of Covid-19 and authorized cities to enact regulations such as requiring face coverings; and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 2020, Mayor Diak of the City of Page, issued a Proclamation Reinstating Precautionary Measures to Slow Covid-19, including certain requirements for face coverings; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2021, Governor Ducey issued Executive Order 2021-06. This Executive Order rescinded several prior COVID-19 Emergency Orders and prohibited cities or towns from implementing any emergency order not in place as of March 11, 2020, including orders pertaining to face coverings; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order 2021-06, businesses and other private entities are encouraged to take and implement precautionary measures to slow the spread of COVID-19, including requiring face coverings if they so choose.

NOW, THEREFORE, as Mayor of the City of Page, County of Coconino, State of Arizona, I do hereby:

- 1. Effective immediately, rescind the November 18, 2020, Proclamation Relating to Precautionary Measures to Slow COVID-19.
