**PROCLAMATION EXTENDING JULY 6, 2020,
PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES TO SLOW COVID-19**

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, declared that a State of Emergency exists in Arizona due to the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, as Mayor of the City of Page ("City"), I declared that a State of Emergency exists in the City due to the COVID-19 outbreak; and

WHEREAS, on July, 6, 2020, I issued a Proclamation Relating to Precautionary Measures to Slow COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the face covering provisions of the July 6, 2020, Proclamation are set to expire on August 1, 2020, unless otherwise extended; and


WHEREAS, the State of Emergency due to COVID-19 continues and precautionary measures such as face coverings are still needed to slow the spread of COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, as Mayor of the City of Page, County of Coconino, State of Arizona, I do hereby:

1. Extend the face covering requirements, exceptions and penalties as detailed in the July 6, 2020, Proclamation Relating to Precautionary Measures to Slow COVID-19. The face covering requirement shall continue in effect until August 31, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. unless otherwise extended or terminated.
2. Businesses that require identification from patrons (e.g. alcohol sales), may require that a patron temporarily remove a face covering for the purposes of identification.
