#### City News Update – April 2, 2020

Page, AZ (April 2, 2020) – There has been a call from community members to have access to demographic, location, and similar data as it relates to COVID-19 in Coconino County. This information is not readily available to the City of Page in a publicly releasable form. As of April 1, 2020, there were 18 confirmed cases in Page, 27 in the Greater Flagstaff area, 60 in tribal communities, and 1 in all other areas of Coconino County for a total of 106.
