Mayor Tappan Issues Proclamation Relating to Precautionary Measures to Slow COVID-19

Page, AZ (July 7, 2020) – Today Mayor Tappan issued a new proclamation pursuant to his declaration of a State of Emergency issued on March 19, 2020, that is designed to serve as a precautionary measure to slow the spread of COVID-19 in the City of Page. The Mayor's latest proclamation replaces Ordinance 673-20 that was passed by the City Council last week.

The declaration requires businesses to comply with Governor Ducey's prevention requirements for businesses, bars, and restaurants. Additionally, properly worn face coverings are required to be worn inside buildings open to the public, with some exceptions. Please refer to the proclamation document for full requirement details.
