Mayor Tappan Renews Proclamation Requiring Face Coverings to August 31st

Page, AZ (August 3, 2020) – On July 30, 2020 Mayor Tappan renewed his proclamation issued on July 6, 2020 that was designed to serve as a precautionary measure to slow the spread of COVID-19 in the City of Page. The July 6 proclamation was set to expire on August 1st unless renewed. The Mayor has now renewed his proclamation and set it to expire on August 31st unless otherwise extended or terminated.

The declaration requires properly worn face coverings to be worn inside buildings open to the public, with some exceptions. The declaration also provides that businesses engaging in alcohol sales may require patrons to temporarily remove face coverings for purposes of identification.
