

ORDINANCE NO. 649-18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CITY OF PAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES, REPEALING § 30.072, SAME DAY PASSAGE PROHIBITED, AND AMENDING § 30.073, TWO SEPARATE READINGS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, THAT § 30.072, SAME DAY PASSAGE PROHIBITED, AND § 30.073 TWO SEPARATE READINGS, OF THE CITY OF PAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES ARE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. § 30.072, SAME DAY PASSAGE PROHIBITED, of the City of Page Code of Ordinances, is hereby repealed in its entirety and § 30.072 shall be reserved for future use in the City of Page Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2. § 30.073, TWO SEPARATE READINGS, of the City of Page Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended as follows:

§ 30.073 TWO SEPARATE READINGS

~~All ordinances except emergency ordinances shall have two separate readings, but the first and the second reading shall never be made on the same day. The first reading may be by title only, but the second reading shall be in full unless the Council, in possession of printed copies of said ordinance, shall unanimously allow reading by title only.~~ **AN ORDINANCE SHALL REQUIRE ONLY ONE (1) READING BEFORE ITS ADOPTION AND MAY BE ADOPTED AT THE SAME MEETING AT WHICH IT IS FIRST INTRODUCED BY A MAJORITY OF THOSE COUNCILMEMBERS PRESENT. THE ORDINANCE MAY BE PRESENTED FOR ADOPTION BY TITLE ONLY UPON UNANIMOUS CONSENT OF THE COUNCILMEMBERS PRESENT. OTHERWISE, THE ORDINANCE SHALL BE PRESENTED FOR ADOPTION IN FULL.**

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, effective thirty (30) days from the adoption hereof.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


SECTION 5. That the City Clerk is authorized to correct typographical and grammatical errors, as well as errors of wording and punctuation, as necessary; and that
