

ORDINANCE NO. 656-19

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR
AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE,
COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, ENACTING
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS RELATING TO
HORSESHOE BEND.**

WHEREAS, the loading and unloading of visitors to Horseshoe Bend in the entry drive and along U.S. Highway 89 has created an immediate safety hazard. In addition, the loading and unloading of passengers in unintended and unwanted areas is interfering with the safe and orderly operation of vehicles attempting to enter the parking area; and

WHEREAS, due to the immediate and ongoing safety hazards to the general public traveling U.S. Highway 89 as well as visitors to Horseshoe Bend, the City Council finds and declares that an emergency exists; and

WHEREAS, the City Council therefore finds that an emergency ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and general welfare of the City of Page, Arizona, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and in force from and after the date of posting hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA:

SECTION 1. Effective immediately, § 71.15, Horseshoe Bend Traffic Regulations, of the City of Page Code of Ordinances, is hereby created as follows:

§71.15 Horseshoe Bend Traffic Regulations.

Parking, loading or unloading passengers in or along the entry road to Horseshoe Bend, also known as Horseshoe Bend Drive, except in city designated areas is prohibited. Loading or unloading passengers in or along U.S. Highway 89 within 1500 feet of the intersection of Horseshoe Bend Drive and U.S. Highway 89 is also prohibited.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a civil sanction as set forth in §71.99, Penalty, Page City Code of Ordinances. A civil sanction imposed pursuant to §71.99 shall not exceed \$300.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining

portions thereof.

SECTION 5. That the City Clerk is authorized to correct typographical and grammatical errors, as well as errors of wording and punctuation, as necessary; and that the City Clerk is authorized to make formatting changes needed for purposes of clarity and form, if required, to be consistent with the Page City Code of Ordinances.
