

ORDINANCE NO. 676-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PAGE § 31.40 SUBSTANCE ABUSE TASK FORCE, SUBSECTION C, INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP TO SEVEN MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Page is currently looking to implement strategies to address substance abuse within the City; and

WHEREAS, numerous individuals have expressed interest in serving on the Substance Abuse Task Force to assist with addressing substance abuse concerns in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Substance Abuse Task Force regulations currently only allow for five members; and

WHEREAS, given the level of interest in serving on the Task Force, the Mayor and City Council find that increasing the number of members that can serve on the Substance Abuse Task Force is needed at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, THAT THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PAGE IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. § 31.40 SUBSTANCE ABUSE TASK FORCE, Subsection C, of the Code of the City of Page, is hereby amended as follows:

§ 31.40 SUBSTANCE ABUSE TASK FORCE.

(C) Membership and selection. The Substance Abuse Task Force shall consist of five SEVEN voting members, all of whom shall be appointed by Council. The term of office of each member shall be four years, except that the term of a person appointed to fill a vacancy shall be for the unexpired term. Two THREE of the five SEVEN members shall be appointed to an initial term of two years in order to stagger the terms of the Task Force members. A Council member appointed by the Mayor may serve as Chair and Council Liaison with no voting privilege.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining

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portions thereof.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk is authorized to correct typographical and grammatical errors, as well as errors of wording and punctuation, as necessary; and that the City Clerk is authorized to make formatting changes needed for purposes of clarity and form, if required, to be consistent with the Page City Code of Ordinances.
