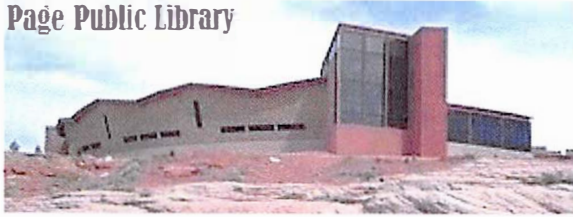

To Page/Lake Powell Area Businesses, Agencies, and Organizations:




