Registration Opens: November 12, 2018

- 1. Register on-line with any computer or phone at https://cityofpage.recdesk.com/Community/Program
- Have staff help you register on-line at the Recreation Department, Page Public Library or Page Community Center
- 3. Fill out a paper form and pay at Page City Hall Monday Thursday; 7 AM 5:30 PM
- 4. Download a registration form at www.cityofpage.org/departments/recreation-dept and leave it with payment in the afterhours deposit box at Page City Hall.
- Pick up a paper registration form at the Recreation Department or request to have the Recreation Department email or text a registration form to you to submit with payment at Page City Hall.

Registration Deadline: January 7, 2019

(Late registration is not guaranteed and may not be accepted if leagues are full. If late registrations are accepted, late shirts may not arrive until the 4th week of games and after team photos are scheduled.)

Fees: \$50/child (If space remains after deadlines, registrations may be accepted with an additional \$10.00 late fee.) Coaches may be eligible for a free future registration voucher.

Coaches: In this community-based league, all coaches are volunteers. We encourage parents, grandparents, and 16+ year old siblings, to coach their players' teams. At the end of the season coaches who have completed all requirements may be eligible to receive a free future registration, and assistant coaches may be eligible to receive a half-price future registration. Please contact the Recreation Department at 928-645-4380/4381 for more details and to obtain volunteer forms. Volunteer forms and concussion training must be completed annually before coaches' mandatory organizational meetings.

Teams/Equipment:

- Requests to put players on teams together or with specific coaches will not be accepted. The Recreation Department sorts players by experience to create teams of similar skill levels and these types of requests contribute to unequally balanced teams. Other than parents coaching their children or placing siblings who are in the same league on the same teams, no other effort will be made to place players on specific teams.
- One team shirt is included with registration.
- For safety, gym shoes are required to play.

Divisions/Games: Games may be played at 5:30 or 6:30 PM. Schedules subject to change based on final number of teams.
