

ORDINANCE NO. 705-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA AMENDING THE CITY OF PAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY DELETING, § 31.21, COMMUNITY CENTER ADVISORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, many residents have offered tremendous community service by participating in the Community Center Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to acknowledge and thank everyone who has served on the Community Center Advisory Board throughout its many years of existence; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to dissolve the Community Center Advisory Board in order to allow for the implementation of a Site Council to gather community feedback and provide assistance in the operation of the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Site Council approach will encourage more public participation and feedback while allowing for more flexible operations in order to meet community needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. § 31.21, COMMUNITY CENTER ADVISORY BOARD, of the City of Page Code of Ordinances is hereby deleted in its entirety and the Community Center Advisory Board is hereby dissolved.

SECTION 3. That the effective date of this Ordinance shall be 30 days from the adoption of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 5. That the City Clerk is authorized to correct typographical and grammatical errors, as well as errors of wording and punctuation, as necessary; and that the City Clerk is authorized to make formatting changes needed for purposes of clarity and form, if required, to be consistent with the Page City Code of Ordinances.
