CANDIDATE PACKET- What Does It Contain?
The **Candidate Election Packet** for the 2022 Election includes the following:

- ✓ Statement of interest *
- ✓ ***MUST BE FILED PRIOR TO COLLECTING SIGNATURES**
- ✓ Statement of Organization
- ✓ Candidate Nonpartisan Nomination Petition
- ✓ Candidate Nonpartisan Nomination Paper
- ✓ Financial Disclosure Statement
- ✓ Financial Disclosure Statement Guide
- ✓ Campaign Finance Candidate Guide

FILING YOUR PAPERS

You must file the following documents with the City Clerk's Office **between 03/05/22 and 04/04/22:**

- ✓ Nonpartisan Nomination Paper Declaration of Qualification
- ✓ Nonpartisan Nomination Petitions signed by **at least 65 and no more than 129** City of Page registered voters
- ✓ Financial Disclosure Statement

E-QUAL

Candidates running for office in Arizona are able to collect 100% of their required nomination petitions signatures online! E-Equal enables eligible voters to electronically sign these petitions. The portal creates a candidate profile with website links to be shared on social media for greater outreach to voters. For candidates that still wish to gather signatures on paper, the system enables a candidate to electronically design a nomination petition that may be printed for in-person circulation. Please call the City Clerk's Office at 928-645-4221 to schedule an appointment to meet with the City Clerk and pick up the Candidate Packet. **Remember, aspiring candidates for office must file a Statement of Interest with the City Clerk before the candidate begins collecting petition signatures (A.R.S. §16-311 (H)).** Guide to sign candidate's online nomination petition [CLICK HERE](#)

CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN FINANCE

TO BEGIN THE PROCESS

- ★ **IF** you plan to receive or expend, *in any combination*, **more than \$500.00** during the election cycle, you must file a Statement of Organization. The election cycle is 01/01/21—12/31/22.
- ★ Be sure to maintain all records because **IF** you go over the \$500.00 limit during the election cycle, you must file a Statement of Organization within 10 days.

Campaign Finance Reports will be due periodically, as indicated on the Campaign Finance Cover Sheet. While the City Clerk's Office may send a reminder to the e-mail listed on the Statement of Organization, **it is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure reports are filed timely.**
