CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN FINANCE

TO BEGIN THE PROCESS

11/05/24

- ★ **IF** you plan to receive or expend, *in any combination*, **more than \$500** during the election cycle, you must file a Statement of Organization.
- ★ Be sure to maintain all records because **IF** you go over the **\$500** limit during the election cycle, you must file a Statement of Organization within 10 days.

Campaign Finance Reports will be due periodically, as indicated on the Campaign Finance Cover Sheet. While the City Clerk's Office may send a reminder to the e-mail listed on the Statement of Organization, it is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure reports are filed timely.

EQUAL



Candidates running for office in Arizona are able to collect 100% of their required nomination petitions signatures online! E-Qual enables eligible voters to electronically sign these petitions. The portal creates a candidate profile with website links to be shared on social media for greater outreach to voters. For candidates that still wish to gather signatures on paper, the system enables a candidate to electronically design a nomination petition that may be printed for in-person circulation. Please call the City Clerk's Office at 928-645-4221 to schedule an appointment to meet with the City Clerk and pick up the Candidate Packet. Remember, aspiring candidates for office must file a Statement of Interest with the City Clerk before the candidate begins collecting petition signatures (A.R.S. §16-311 (H).
