

RESOLUTION NO. 1350-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAGE, ARIZONA ADOPTING THE 2026 COCONINO COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Page recognizes the threat that natural and human-caused hazards pose to the people, property, environment, economy, and infrastructure of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) requires state and local governments to develop and maintain hazard mitigation plans as a condition of eligibility for certain federal disaster assistance and hazard mitigation grant programs administered by the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, the 2026 Coconino County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies hazards affecting the City of Page and participating jurisdictions, assesses vulnerability and risk, and establishes mitigation goals, objectives, and actions intended to reduce long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS, the City of Page coordinated with Coconino County Emergency Management on the development and update of the 2026 Coconino County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan in cooperation with other participating jurisdictions, stakeholders, tribal partners, community organizations, and the public; and

WHEREAS, the planning process included opportunities for public involvement and intergovernmental coordination consistent with federal and state planning guidance; and

WHEREAS, participating jurisdictions in the Plan include Coconino County, the City of Flagstaff, the City of Page, the City of Williams, the Town of Fredonia, the Town of Tusayan, and Northern Arizona University; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the 2026 Coconino County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan demonstrates the City's continued commitment to reducing disaster risk, enhancing resilience, and protecting the health, safety, and welfare of residents and visitors throughout the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Page, Arizona as follows:

1. The Mayor and City Council hereby adopt the 2026 Coconino County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, including all appendices and supporting documentation, as an official plan of the City of Page.

2. The Mayor and City Council authorize the City's Fire Chief to assist the Director of Coconino County Emergency Management to coordinate State and Federal approval of the Plan, as well as implementation, maintenance, monitoring, and future updates of the Plan in accordance with applicable federal and state requirements. The City Fire Chief will provide the Mayor and City Council with any changes made during this approval process.
3. The Mayor and City Council encourage all City departments, participating jurisdictions, partner agencies, and stakeholders to support implementation of the mitigation strategies and actions identified within the Plan.
4. The adoption of this Resolution shall not obligate the expenditure of City of Page funds beyond those appropriated through the normal budgeting process.
